## PROGRAMMATIC HIGHLIGHTS

### SHELTER - NFIs - WASH

-  **179,524** Individuals benefitted from hygiene promotion activities.
-  **24,412** Individuals benefitted from cash-based assistance for shelter.
- NFI 44,712** Individuals benefitted from Emergency Shelter - Non Food Items (ES-NFIs) assistance.
-  **4,264** Individuals benefitted from rehabilitation of water infrastructure.
-  **5,500** Individuals benefitted from rehabilitation of sanitation facilities.
-  **24,412** Individuals benefitted from transitional shelter support.

### HEALTH

-  **9,313** Medical consultations conducted.
-  **17,842** Individuals benefitted from health awareness sessions.
-  **2,115** Children less than five years old screened for malnutrition.
-  **2,530** Women of reproductive age benefitted from sexual and reproductive health services.
- H 822** Health assessments conducted.

## DISPLACEMENT TRACKING MATRIX (DTM)

- **124,996** Internally Displaced People (IDPs) identified through Emergency Tracking Tool.
- **11,217** migrants identified at flow monitoring points.
- 1 national report, flow monitoring report, and 5 weekly ETTs are produced
- 7 information sharing workshops conducted.

## RETURNS & REINTEGRATION

- **869** returnees from Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA) were registered, profiled and screened for vulnerabilities upon arrival.
- **869** returnees from KSA assisted with onward transportation allowance (OTA) and NFIs.
- **75** Unaccompanied Migrant Children (UMCs) assisted with FTR (Family Tracing and Reunification) and reinsertion cash grant.
- **200** returnees received economic and social support.
- **114** returnees received reintegration counselling and vulnerabilities assessment
- **39** returnees received one-on-one and group psychosocial counselling.
- **96** returnees received kaizen, Entrepreneurship, vocational and Psycho Social Support (PSS) training.

## MIGRATION GOVERNANCE

- Regional Development and Protection Programme (RDPP) stakeholders coordination meeting was held in Addis Ababa to improve livelihood and educations services to urban refugees and host communities in Addis Ababa.
- Provided financial and technical support for the National Partnership Coalition (NPC) to develop and validate 'National Voluntary Report on the Implementation of Global Compact on Migration (GCM)'. The report is prepared by a team represented by different government ministries and lead by the NPC.
- Virtual entrepreneurship training to Ethiopian diaspora entrepreneurs residing in the Netherlands was provided from 7th - 28th November 2020 under the framework of Entrepreneurship for Development (ED4D) project.

## BEHAVIOUR CHANGE COMMUNICATIONS (BCC)

- **250** copies of Training of Trainers (ToT) guideline was printed for a training.
- Community Conversation Facilitators (CCF) manual translated into Afan Oromo, Amharic and Tigrigna languages.
- **37** participants received CCF ToT in Oromia region.
- **265** potential migrants received services through the hotline.
- **2,800** Information Education Communication (IEC) materials distributed.

## PROTECTION

- 31 migrants who were supported through Emergency Migration Response Centre (EMRC) were identified for employment support.

## MENTAL HEALTH & PSYCHOSOCIAL SUPPORT

- 6,768 individuals received MHPSS services.
- 18,037 individuals participated in protection awareness sessions.

## OPERATIONS

- 179 refugees departed Ethiopia for resettlement purposes.
- Documents of 67 refugees and migrants verified for different Embassies.
